This report departs from similar, previous, work in regard to the content format – it has the minimal, necessary explanatory text and, therefore, uses direct scans of source documents and images so as to show the actuality, and the manner, in which the UK State has, over the last eight years, been complicit in political and military interventions in Ukraine with (in particular) the intention of giving support to the US-installed Kyiv régime, in its brutal war against the people of Donbass and of Crimea.

The context for this report is therefore the events leading up to – and following – the military intervention by Russia in the Ukraine civil war, on the 24<sup>th</sup> February 2022.

The investigation has therefore included that of the manner in which the UK State has played a major part in the manufacturing and the dissemination of extreme anti-Russia propaganda, as an ‘influence and control operation’ directed against the domestic (UK) civilian population, both prior to and (especially) following that February 2022 Russian intervention.

This is seen as a process, engineered by the UK State, of both fomenting and exacerbating the civil war in Ukraine, and of creating the conditions in which the UK can be a major actor in a more extensive war in Europe between the USA controlled ‘The West’, and Russia.

This work is an ongoing project.

Britain should push to rebuild a 5,000-strong Nato response force to boost the alliance's ability to defend itself against Russia, an outgoing senior officer said yesterday.

General Sir Richard Shirreff, who stepped down as Nato's top British commander in March, also called for the alliance to establish a permanent presence in the Baltics to deter Moscow from mounting an attack.

On account of the crisis in Ukraine, he said that he wanted to see a revival of the kind of exercises Nato used to conduct during the Cold War that involved the military and political leaders responding to a mock nuclear crisis.

His suggestions, before a committee of MPs, were supported by two of Britain's most highly regarded Russia experts - James Sherr, associate fellow at Chatham House, and Chris Donnelly, director of the Institute for Statecraft.

Asked whether he thought Russia would attempt an attack on the Baltics within ten years, General Shirreff said: "If Nato is not bold, strategic and ambitious, the chances are high."

Mr Donnelly agreed with him that Britain should take a lead role because of London's ability to attract support from Washington, which has shown waning interest in the transatlantic alliance as it pivots towards the Pacific.

Note the reference to the organization **The Institute for Statecraft**. Whilst Chris DONNELLY is listed as the Director, it is now known that James SHERR works as a Senior Fellow (covering Russia, Eastern Europe and the CIS), for that particular organization.

This report shows the extent to which The Institute For Statecraft operates as an anti-Russia propaganda arm for the UK State apparatus (political, media and military).

Ukrainian special forces and military intelligence officers are helping the British Army to understand how President Putin fights.

A group of highly experienced reservists visited the UK last month to give briefings on the way that Russian forces integrate high-end conventional weapons, electronic jamming devices, covert sabotage missions, and the exploitation of social media.

It is rare for such an exchange to take place and is in contrast to the very public basic infantry training that British soldiers have been giving to their Ukrainian counterparts.

"We now have something to learn from them in terms of modern highend warfare and hybrid operations," a defence source said.

What the Ukrainians have been experiencing since Russia's annexation of Crimea two and a half years ago "is World War III on a tiny scale", he said.

The Ministry of Defence spokesman said: "We have been open and clear about the support we have provided to Ukraine, including valuable training for Ukrainian armed forces through a range of programmes, and a small delegation from Ukraine was hosted as part of a think tank-sponsored visit"

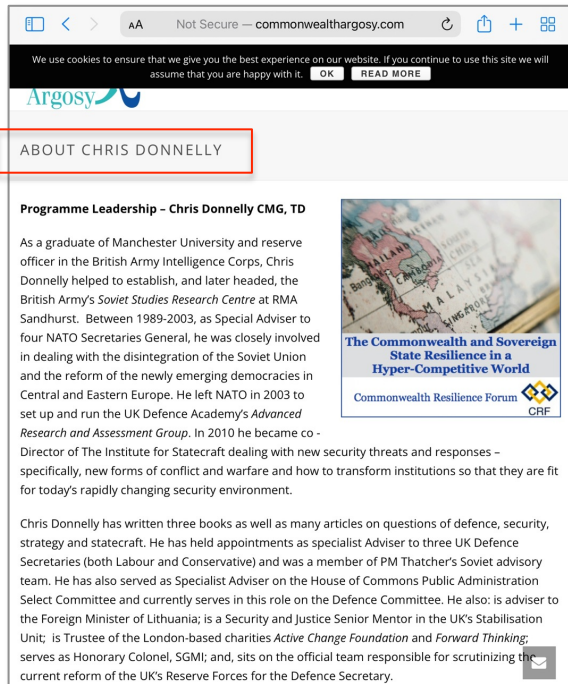

A high-ranking commander of Ukraine's Azov battalion has been found dead in his apartment in the town of Bucha, outside Kyiv.

The press service of the Azov regiment, formerly a volunteer militia unit, said on Twitter on July 27 that Yaroslav Babych, a deputy chief of Azov's civil staff, was found hanged in the morning of July 26.

No further details were immediately available.


Investigations have been launched into the death.

The Azov Battalion was formed in 2014 to fight Russian-backed separatists in Ukraine's eastern regions of Donetsk and Luhansk.

Yaroslav BABYCH – identified as having been a leading figure in the Ukrainian RIGHT SECTOR movement, the co-founder and Deputy Head of the AZOV Battalion, and as a prime mover in the incorporation of AZOV into the Ukraine National Guard, in circa late 2014.

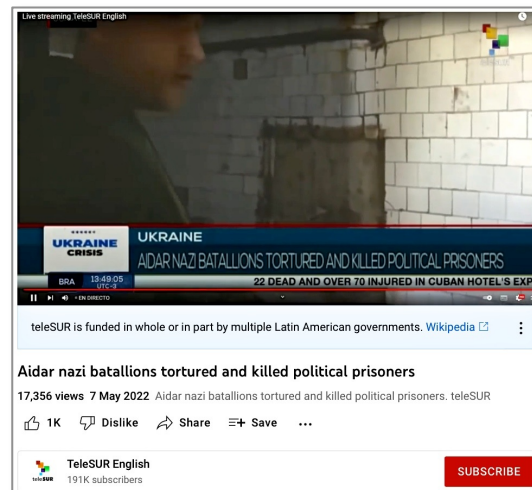
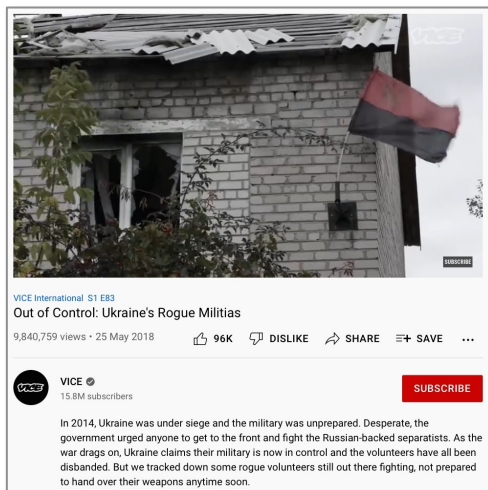
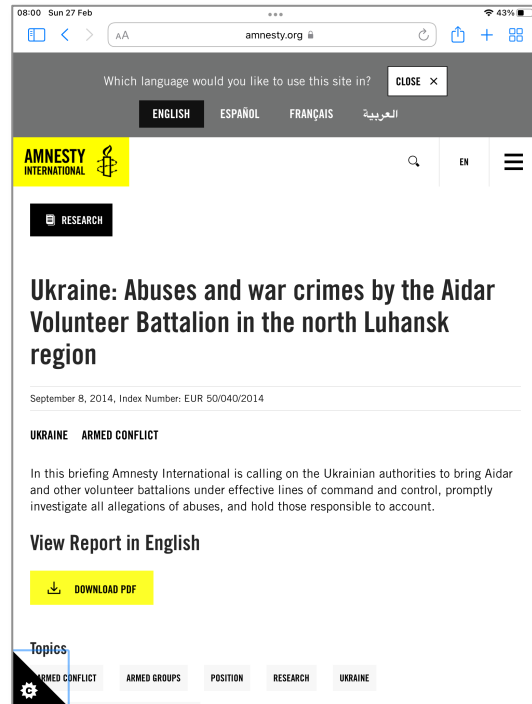

A fragile ceasefire began in east Ukraine last night, halting a two-week counter-offensive by pro-Russian fighters that reversed the tide of the conflict and forced Kiev to cut a deal.


Under the terms of the plan agreed by Ukrainian, Russian and rebel negotiators in Minsk, both sides began a truce at 6pm local time that clears the way for prisoner swaps, the introduction of humanitarian aid and international monitors, and the withdrawal of heavy weapons from the region.

Andriy Biletskiy, founder of the ultranationalist Azov Battalion, whose 500 volunteer fighters are the most visible defenders of the city, recounted a night of heavy fighting beyond the outskirts on Thursday. "It was an artillery duel - we were fired at all night. The enemy was 5km away from the city. Now they are 20 km away."

He said he hoped that any ceasefire would not be permanent and implied that he might not observe it if it was. "The enemy is still on our territory. As soldiers, we will obey orders [to stop shooting]. As citizens, we will not admit this ceasefire." Did he mean guerrilla war? "We will see."

Note the description / acknowledgement of the AZOV Battalion by Ben HOYLE and Deborah HAYNES as being "ultranationalists" (newspeak for neo NAZIs). Also, there is the obvious disappointment (from 'The West') that a ceasefire had been agreed between the Kyiv régime, and the Donbass separatists.

But Fenech is known for his services in weapons supply and maritime security with companies **Fieldsports**, Outdoor Gear Supplies Ltd, PBM, **RAE Malta**, Safety At Sea Logistics, Sovereign Charterers, and Stategic Supplies Ltd. All companies fall under his Unified Global Services Group.


Superintendent George Cremona and Inspector Omar Zammit prosecuted. Magistrate Victor Axiaq presided. Lawyers Joseph Giglio, Patrick Valentino and Stephen Tonna Lowell appeared for Fenech.

Fenech's Fieldsports had once partnered with infamous former US private militia operator Erik Prince, in a venture that was reportedly set to produce and sell ammunition. A 2007 report by the European Parliament had found that Malta had, at the time, been the operational base for Prince's private militia company, formerly known as Blackwater.

Note the apparent connection between **Vidmantas EITUTIS** and **The Institute For Statecraft**.

Note also, in particular, the reference to an Institute For Statecraft 'mission' being in Ukraine for 3 months – from May 2014 to July 2014. The timeline context is therefore this: (1) the self-rule plebiscite elections in Donetsk and Luhansk on the 11<sup>th</sup> May 2014; (2) the Ukraine Presidential Election on the 25<sup>th</sup> May 2014; (3) the re-launch of the so-called Anti-Terrorism Operation in Donbas on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2014; and (4) the NATO Summit, Wales, on the 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> September 2014.

The videos also show the men being chased by the residents, with locals shouting at them and calling them "Blackwater."

On March 5, an unnamed Russian diplomat in the Ukrainian capital, Kiev, told Russia's Interfax news agency that 300 employees of private security companies had arrived in Ukraine.

"These are soldiers of fortune proficient in combat operations. Most of them had operated under private contracts in Iraq, Afghanistan and other states," he said.

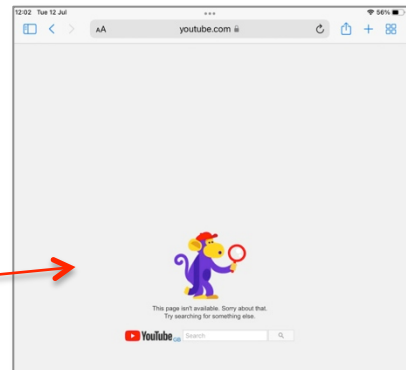
The source, however, did not reveal nationalities of the "soldiers," but said they are mostly from the United States.

Donetsk was the scene of unrest this week as pro-Russian residents seized control of the regional administration headquarters.

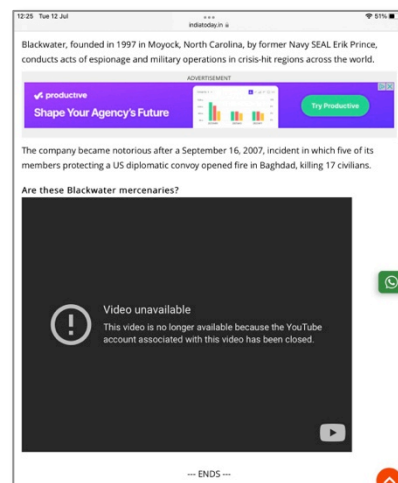
Blackwater was founded in 1997 in Moyock, North Carolina, by former Navy SEAL Erik Prince with the aim of conducting acts of espionage and military operations in crisis-hit regions across the world.

The company became notorious following a September 16, 2007, incident in which five of its guards protecting a US diplomatic convoy opened fire in the Iraqi capital, Baghdad, killing 17 civilians.

The company had also faced allegations under the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act regarding its conduct in Iraq and Sudan in relation to unlicensed training of foreign nationals and firearms violations.



The 'disappeared' videos



The relevance of this is in regard to **Vidmantas EITUTIS** given in regarding **RAE MALTA**, and to **BLACKWATER** (a US private military business, operating as a proxy for US Government forces).

My personal recollection is of seeing video reports of the 'special forces' in Donetsk shouting at local people in English, with very distinct American accents. Notably, those videos have been erased from social media (YOUTUBE, *et al*).

## Lithuanian former journalist says country tried to deny speech, send him to prison

Algirdas Paleckis, a Lithuanian politician, diplomat and former investigative journalist, said June 7 his country failed to investigate what he considers a sniper attack on innocent civilians in January of 1991.

"Lithuania broke away from the USSR in late 1991, but earlier, in January 1991, the Soviet troops took over the Vilnius TV center and 14 people died," Paleckis said at a National Press Club Newsmaker. "The Lithuanian government blamed the troops but presented practically no evidence and until now did not bring the investigation to the end."

Paleckis said he did his own investigation of the 1991 event and "found many witnesses, and also the ballistic expertise indicating that there were secret snipers shooting from the roofs of houses into the civilians in January, 1991 at the Vilnius TV center."

`` It appears in January, 1991, our own people were shooting at their natives."

Paleckis described himself as active in the Socialist People's Front, a board member of "World Without Nazism," a human rights organization, and a speaker of six languages. Born in 1971, he is a graduate of Vilnius University with degrees in journalism and political science. He is a former member of the Lithuanian Parliament and former Vice-Mayor of Vilnius, the capital.

As result of his claims, Paleckis said the country's ruling party "initiated a trial against him by writing a letter to the state prosecutor." He was charged with "denying the Soviet aggression against Lithuania." He said he won the first court handling the charges but faces "the crucial appeal session of the court scheduled for June 12." He said he could be sent to prison for two years if convicted.

"This law is in a fundamental conflict with the international treaties protecting freedom of speech," Paleckis said.

Algirdas PALECKIS: a Lithuanian politician arrested and imprisoned for exploring evidence that the killing of protesting Lithuanian civilians (protesting against the presence of Russian military) by snipers was a 'false flag' operation – that the snipers were, in fact, from the anti-Russia Lithuanian 'independence' movement.

The relevance (in regard to this report) is the Lithuanian State officials and operatives within (for example) connections to the UK based Institute For Statecraft – i.e. former (First) Defence Minister Andrius BUTKEVICUS and Colonel (retired) Vidmantas EITUTIS (as described within this report).

## LITHUANIA 1991 – A ‘Snipers’ Atrocity’ False flag? [2]

This became evident from the interview with political strategist **Audrius Butkevičius**, who was the Director of the Department of National Defense in the early 1990s. By the way, he is being named as the main orchestrator of the January 1991 drama.



**Gene Sharp’s favorite student Audrius Butkevičius successfully used his teachings in the field.**

He has a striking and extraordinary personality -- one of his majors was psychotherapy. In 2000, he gave a rather explicit interview in the Lithuanian paper *Obzor*, in which he admitted that on 13 January 1991, he deliberately aimed for civilian casualties. He held no regrets, since the deaths “delivered a powerful blow to two main pillars of the Soviet authority, the army and the KGB,” which never recovered. “Yes, I planned to place the Soviet army in a very uncomfortable psychological position, so any officer would feel shame for being there.” We have to admit, he did a great job... Later Butkevičius said that the *Obzor* journalist made everything up and even went a little crazy, but didn’t demand the paper to do

2014: Maidan protesters' (anti-Russia) witness statement, overwhelmingly referring to the prevalent 'common knowledge' that the snipers were brought to (and removed from) the scene by some of the organizers of the Maidan protest – and that they were 'foreigners' from the Baltic region (i.e. Lithuania) and Georgia. The snipers were shooting at both the Ukrainian security police (Berkut) and the Maidan protesters – causing numerous deaths and injuries.

group known to have close, collaborative links with such organizations as Radio Free Europe, Radio Liberty, NATO, and Charter 97 (a group strongly opposed to both President Lukashenko of Belarus, and his preference for maintaining an alliance with Russia).<sup>419</sup>

There is substantive evidence that show the particular connections between NATO and Charter97. In September 2005 a NATO seminar was held in Vilnius (Lithuania) for the purpose of discussing strategies required to destabilize Belarus, undermine the Belarus Government, and to instigate 'regime change' such that Belarus could eventually be subsumed into the EU and NATO.<sup>420</sup>

Prominent amongst the delegates was a member of the Belarus opposition 'youth resistance movement' ZUBR (Bison), and who was also a key member of Charter97. Recent material produced by Charter97 also indicates support for the 'Maidan' coup in Ukraine.<sup>421</sup>

According to NATO Parliamentary records for September 2005 (on coordinating regime change in Belarus) there is this: "*Uladzimir Kobets, one of the coordinators of the [Belarus] youth resistance movement ZUBR (bison), reminded the audience of the role of such youth groups like OTPOR, KMARA, and PORA in bringing change to Serbia, Georgia and Ukraine.*"<sup>422</sup> Notably OTPOR has been connected to the CANVAS project, to the US-based private intelligence organization STRATFOR, to USAID, and to the US-based National Endowment for Democracy (NED).<sup>423</sup>

In February 2011 a journalist for a Latvian newspaper gave this description of the NED: "*Of course, the NED has nothing to do with democracy. Perhaps there are a few sparkly-eyed idealists, but the board of directors of the NED has well known hawks, including Frank Carlucci, a former defense secretary, deputy director of the CIA, and representative of the Carlyle Group; retired NATO General Wesley Clark; the architect of the invasion of Afghanistan Zalmay Khalilzad; as well as Vin Weber (a colleague of former Secret of State Madeleine Albright on the 'US Policy Reform in the Arab World' working group, as well as a co-founder with Dick Cheney and Donald Rumsfeld of the Project for a New American Century).*"<sup>424</sup>

## 18 Conclusions

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2011 Anders Behring Breivik acted with horrific cruelty in the brutal murder of 77 people.

It was a false flag operation. Anders Behring Breivik presented his actions as those of a "*militant European nationalist*". However his real intentions were: (a) to help prevent the emergence of any effective

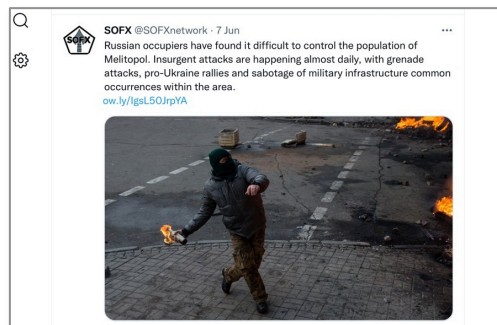
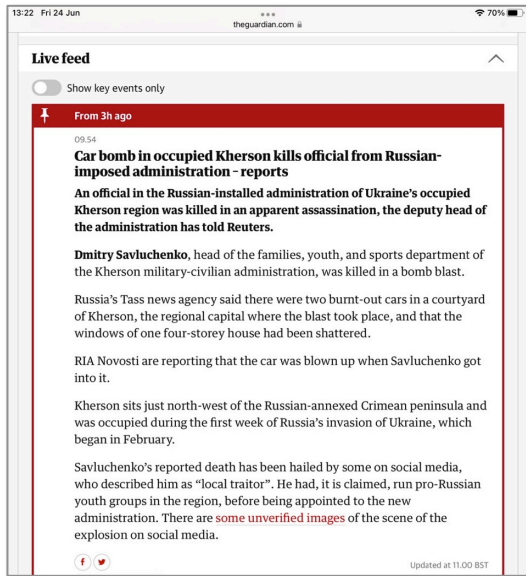

**As Ukraine's military steps up its strikes on Kherson, hinting at a new offensive to recapture the region, there is another force working alongside. They are Ukraine's shadow army, a network of agents and informers who operate behind enemy lines.**

Our journey to meet the resistance fighters takes us through a landscape of sunflower yellow and sky blue to Mykolaiv. The first major town on Ukrainian-controlled territory west of Kherson, it has become the partisans' headquarters on the southern front.

The expressions 'resistance fighters' and 'partisans' are used with the intention of installing within the (unconscious) minds of the general public the notion that Ukrainian militia groups (including neo NAZI groups, such as AZOV) are equivalent to the actual anti-NAZI fighters in occupied Europe, during WW2.

This is 'part and parcel' of the same bizarre narrative, concocted by 'The West', that Russia is the new Third Reich and that Vladimir Putin is the new Hitler.

The true intention is to stop any elections / plebiscite within the Donbass region (for self-determination).

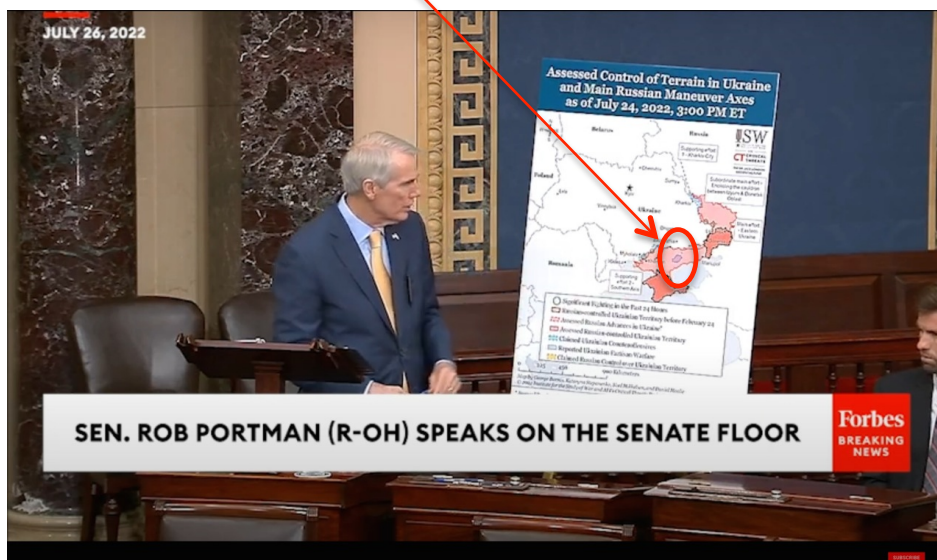
